Victoria Falls, Zambia and Zimbabwe

Mosi-oa-Tunya, meaning “the smoke that thunders” is what the locals call Victoria Falls, a beautiful waterfall on the Zambezi River at the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. The best view of this natural spectacle is by helicopter, though many visit the falls in person. It is the only waterfall in the world that is more than a kilometer in length and is considered to be the largest in the world. The noise of the water can be heard from a distance of 25 miles, which is no wonder why the local tribes call it the way they do.

Giraffe Manor, Kenya

As one of Nairobi’s most iconic retreats, the historic Giraffe Manor dates to the 1930s and offers a unique opportunity to interact with the Rothschild giraffe that resides there. In the mornings or evenings, these giraffes join you, quite literally, for breakfast. Here, the Rothschild giraffes will poke their long necks into the windows of the dining area in search of a treat. The guests are able to directly interact with them and have a truly unique experience. It is the only place in the world where you can feed and photograph these giraffes over your tables, and view them from your bedroom window. Surrounding the Giraffe Manor, is a beautiful forest with over 180 different bird species that you can meet.

Airport: Wilson Airport (WIL) or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO)

Cairo, Egypt
