

Explore These 5 Beautiful and Remote Destinations Accessible only by Private Jet

TELLURIDE, COLORADO

Situated in the southwestern region of Colorado, Telluride is one of the best ski destinations and named the #1 ski resort in North America by Conde Nast Traveler's annual reader survey for five years in a row. With an average of 300 inches of snowfall per year and world-class skiing terrain, Telluride is accessible by flying a private jet into the Telluride Regional airport (TEX). Once there, visitors are greeted with beautiful views of the San Juan Mountains and a charming downtown full of luxury boutique shopping, fine dining and glamorous resorts.

TIWI ISLANDS, AUSTRALIA

Nicknamed the 'Island of Smiles,' the Tiwi Islands consist of two islands – Bathurst and Melville, and are famous for their traditional lifestyle and art. From schools decorated in art murals, to carved burial poles, the Tiwi people paint, weave, sculpt, carve and tell stories that give meaning to their traditional rituals.

Part of the Northern Territory of Australia, the Tiwi Islands are 50 miles north of Darwin and are inhabited by approximately 3,000 Tiwi indigenous Australians. A visit to this community via private jet into the Bathurst Island airport (BRT) provides a truly immersive cultural experience full of indigenous history and art for travelers to discover.

NIMMO BAY, CANADA

The Nimmo Bay Wilderness Resort in British Columbia's Great Bear Rainforest was chosen by National Geographic as one of its unique lodges of the world. Accessible only by helicopter, this remote resort is a beautiful secret retreat tucked away into the wilderness.

With scenic views of mountains, waterfalls and glaciers, the resort offers wildlife encounters and farm-to-table food and wine options. Depending on what you like, you can fly-fish, whale watch or spot a grizzly bear on a hiking trip just to name a few. Fly into the Port Hardy airport (YZT) and take a helicopter or a Spruce Goose float plane to Nimmo Bay for an unforgettable journey.

NECKER ISLAND, BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

Famous for being owned by Sir Richard Branson, who is a founder of the Virgin Group, Necker Island is a 74-acre island nestled in the beautiful British Virgin Islands and is frequently visited by celebrities all around the world. The island accommodates up to 34 people in the luxury resort and is accessible by flying a private jet into the Beef Island airport (EIS).

Though severely damaged by the category 5 Hurricane Irma, Necker Island plans to re-open its resort next month.
